

LAKEHILLS FARMERS MARKET

1. General Market Guidelines

- a. This is a RAIN or SHINE Market with the exception of severe weather, more than 90% chance of rain, or act of God. I understand RAIN or SHINE Market means NON-REFUNDABLE. We will provide MAKE-UP DATES NOT refunds to vendors who have paid for a day. If you are not a monthly vendor, and in the event of a cancellation, we will give you 30 days to pick a make update. Monthly vendors will receive one additional date at the end of their contract.
- b. Smoking is not allowed inside or near the market area.
- c. A standard vendor stall is 10 feet x 10 feet.
- d. Unless provided, vendors must bring a 10x10 canopy, secured with a minimum of 20 lb. weight (per leg) to prevent it from becoming loose due to wind and/or inclement weather.
- e. Vendor is responsible for bringing all needed extension cords if electricity is purchased.
- f. Sign in at Information Desk for assigned space.
- g. Once the market has begun, no moving vehicles are allowed within the market area as a safety precaution.
- h. Must be set up and ready for sales by market start time.
- i. Vendors will not play music without obtaining written permission
- j. Must be out of the property by 2pm.
- k. All trash must be removed or placed in the dumpster. Boxes must be broken down.

2. Laws & Regulations

- a. You are required to abide by all state and local guidelines including food safety requirements and licenses. If you are required to obtain a food permit, sales & tax certificate or mobile vending license, it is your responsibility to provide a copy of such permit to the market manager with your application and have it available for possible inspections.
- b. If required, please provide a copy of your sales and tax certificate issued by the Texas Comptroller to the market manager with the application and have a copy available to display in your tent.
- c. All products including nonfood items, are subject to state and local health requirements and licensing.
- d. Copies of food licenses and permits must be kept in the canopy for the duration.

- e. All Vendors must abide by the health code and restrictions of Bandera County.
- f. All Vendors who produce food and/or agricultural products or manufacture non-agricultural goods and have obtained the necessary permits and licenses are eligible to sell at the market.
- g. Payments are via cash at the market or online via Quickbooks.
Payments are due:
 - i. Weekly vendors - Upon application and the 1st of the month.
 - ii. Biweekly - Upon application and the 1st market of the month.
 - iii. Monthly - Upon application and the 1st of the month.
 - iv. Quarterly - Upon application and quarterly market date.
